Course Syllabus Health Economics 2024 ASSA Continuing Education

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<u>Course Overview:</u> This "mini-course" applies theoretical and empirical tools to the study of health insurance and the healthcare sector. This course will cover a broad range of topics including the demand for healthcare and health insurance, the behavior of non-profit and for-profit hospitals, the sources of technological change in the healthcare sector, and the effects of government regulations on the healthcare market. We will also study the role of adverse selection and moral hazard in healthcare markets, both theoretically and empirically. The course will briefly discuss healthcare systems around the world and describe socioeconomic disparities in health outcomes in both the United States and around the world.
